Philatelic Society of Western Australia (Inc)

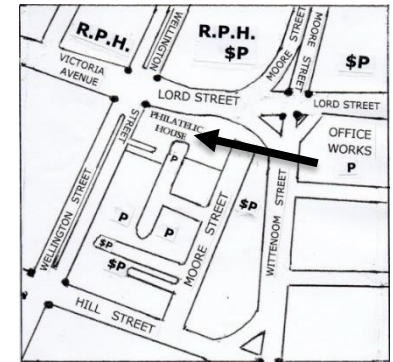
Founded 1893
